



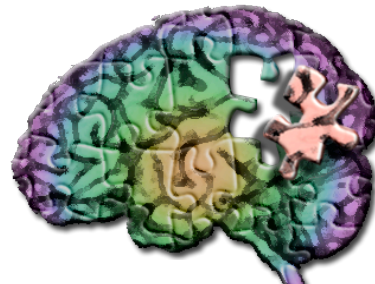
# STANFORD UNIVERSITY RESEARCH

- Male
- Between 21 and 28 years of age
- Diagnosed with Fragile X syndrome or a non-specific developmental disability
- IQ between 40 and 70 points
